



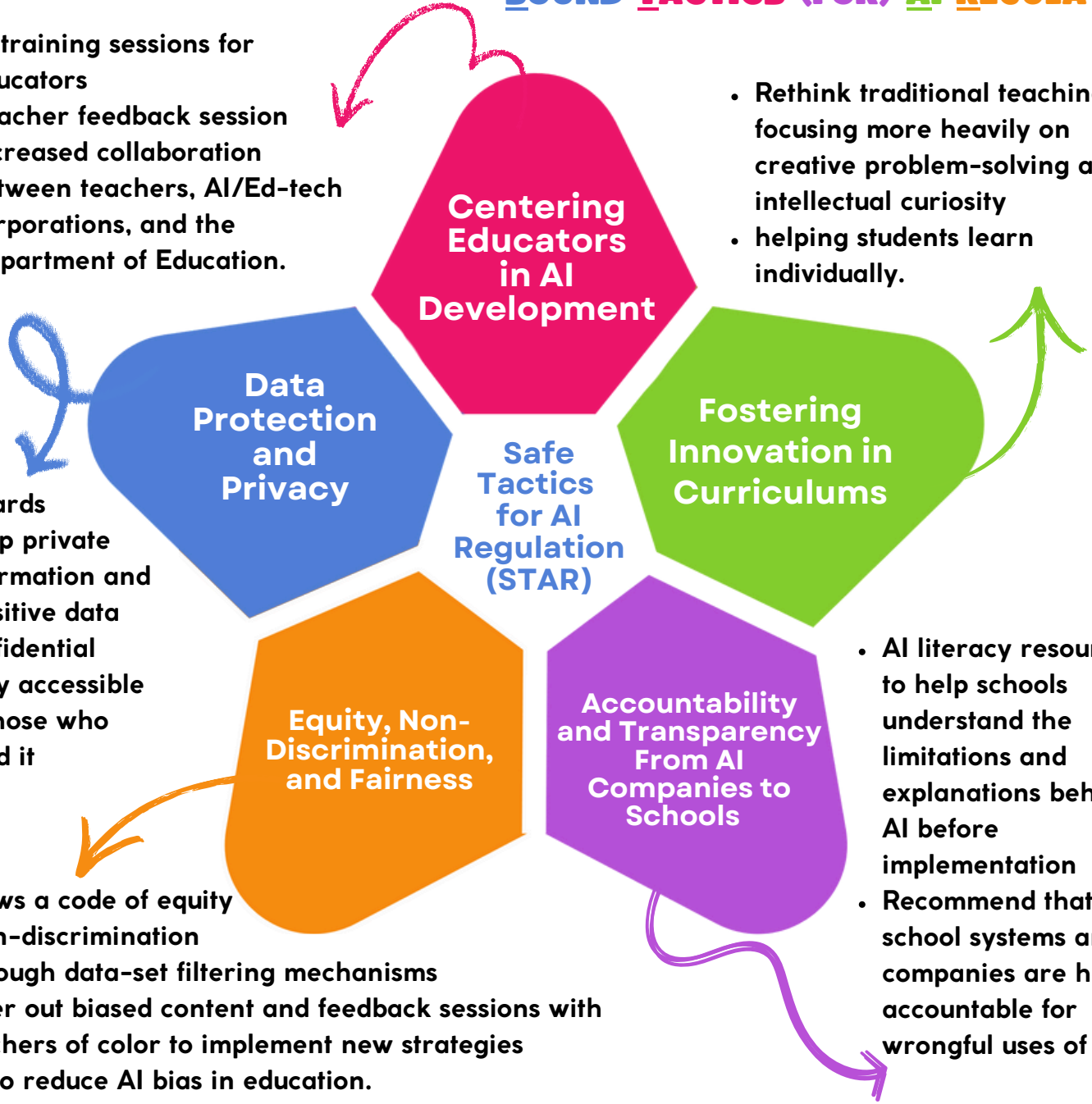

**SOUND TACTICS (FOR) AI REGULATION**

- AI training sessions for educators
- Teacher feedback session
- Increased collaboration between teachers, AI/Ed-tech corporations, and the Department of Education.

- Rethink traditional teaching, focusing more heavily on creative problem-solving and intellectual curiosity
- helping students learn individually.



**Safeguards**

- Keep private information and sensitive data confidential
- Only accessible to those who need it

**AI follows a code of equity and non-discrimination**

- Through data-set filtering mechanisms
- Filter out biased content and feedback sessions with teachers of color to implement new strategies
- All to reduce AI bias in education.

- AI literacy resources to help schools understand the limitations and explanations behind AI before implementation
- Recommend that school systems and AI companies are held accountable for wrongful uses of AI.
